

Part 6

Make F segments for the Nine Patch Block

Make F strip sets and sew more segments to the Quilt Block.

Cutting

1. Fabric 2 :

- (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip cut from selvage to selvage.
- (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 25" strip

2. Fabric 4 :

- (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip cut from selvage to selvage.
- (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 25" strip

Sewing the Fabrics

1. Sew a long Fabric 2 strip to a Fabric 4 strip of the same size.
2. Press to set the seam. Press seam allowance towards Fabric 4.
3. The strip set (F) should measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide along its entire length. Individual strips should be 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide.
4. Make another (shorter) strip set from the 25" long strips.

5. Square up one end of each strip set, and then cut (40) 1 1/2" segments.
6. Sew one segment (horizontally) along the top edge of the block, with Fabric 2 on the left side as shown.
7. Sew another segment below the block, horizontally, with Fabric 2 positioned to the right.
8. Press seam allowances either direction.
9. Repeat for all 20 quilt blocks.
